**ORDER GRANTING LIQUIDATING TRUSTEE'S *EX PARTE* MOTION TO APPROVE RESTORATION AND PAYMENT OF ELECTRONIC DATABASE COSTS**

Before the Court is Barry E. Mukamal's, in his capacity as liquidating trustee ("*Liquidating Trustee*") for the Palm Beach Finance Partners Liquidating Trust and the Palm Beach Finance II Liquidating Trust (collectively, the "*Liquidating Trusts*"), *Ex Parte* Motion to Approve Restoration and Payment of Electronic Database Costs ("*Motion*").<sup>1</sup> Having reviewed the Motion, the Court:

**ORDERS** as follows:

<sup>1</sup> Capitalized terms not defined in this Order shall have the meaning ascribed to such term as set forth in the Motion.

1. The Motion is granted. The Liquidating Trustee is authorized to enter into the Novus Agreement on the terms set forth therein.

2. The Court finds that the costs associated with Novus Agreement are entitled to administrative priority pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(1)(A) and 507(a)(2).

3. The Liquidating Trustee is authorized to pay Capital Novus (a) the \$3,500 restoration fee and (b) the monthly costs associated with the electronic database. Such costs shall be split between the Liquidating Trusts as follows: 18% for Palm Beach Finance Partners, LP and 82% for Palm Beach Finance II, LP.
